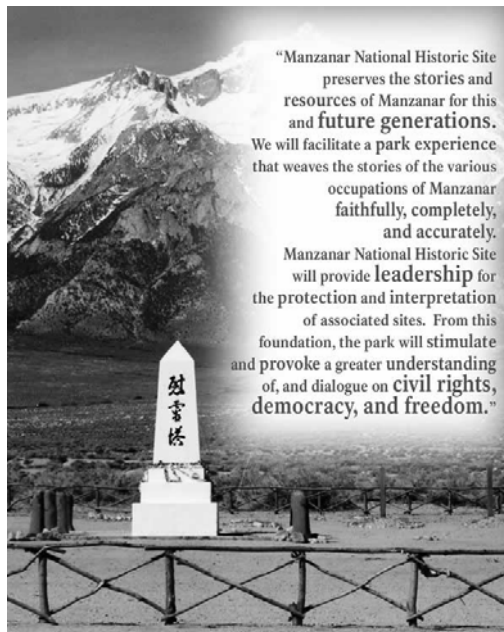

- A stop at Erick Schat's Bakkerij in Bishop to pick up a loaf of the "original sheepherder bread."
- A stop at Bodie State Historic Park, the oldest mining ghost town in the West since the 1800's. Today Bodie is in a state of "arrested decay".
- A stop at Mono Lake to explore the Mono Basin National Forest Scenic Area Visitor Center, which provides an excellent introduction to the Mono Basin, its geology, ecology, and human history.
- Breathtaking views of Mt. Whitney and the Alabama Hills
